

Metal Art.

Visitors to the Club will observe displays of more than 300 pieces of metal art created by members of the club. The village store also displays a significant number of pieces of metal art. These items may be purchased either at the Village Store or the Metal Club.



SCW Arts and Crafts Fair

Club members are active participants in the Fall [November] and Spring [March] SCW Arts and Crafts Fairs. Over 1,500 pieces of metal art are on display and available for purchase at each Fair.
