The SCW Metal Club recently installed a new powder coating facility which has been a great addition for the club. Powder coating is the process of spraying a fine powder on an electrically charged metal object which causes the powder to adhere to the object. The object is then heated in an oven causing the powder to flow smoothly over the item to form a durable, weather-resistant, professional coated finish.

Club members can sign-up for the Powder Coating class to learn how to powder coat an item of their choice including metal art, automotive parts, bicycle frames, mailboxes, etc.

If you're interested in learning more about the powder coating process, stop by the Metal Club for a shop tour. Classes in Powder Coating and other metal-related fields are available to club members.
