Software Download Info:

- 1. Download the free trial version of VCarve Pro. Go to www.vectric.com
- 2. In the Menu along the top click on 'Free Trail' and select 'VCarve Pro'
- 3. Click on 'Download VCarve Pro Trail' a box will pop up.
- 4. You can either create an account or click 'Download as Guest' and press Start
- 5. You will need to add the Marketspace ID to be able to post process on the computers at the Club.
 - To add the Marketspace ID, go to 'Help' in VCarve Pro on the dropdown menu go to the very bottom 'About VCarve Pro Makerspace Client'. In the pop-up box click on 'Enter Markerspace ID' and enter the following number:

8547F-6CB34-EEB01-BB2DF-981FF-312F2-A87AF

You will need to restart VCarve for the ID to become active.
